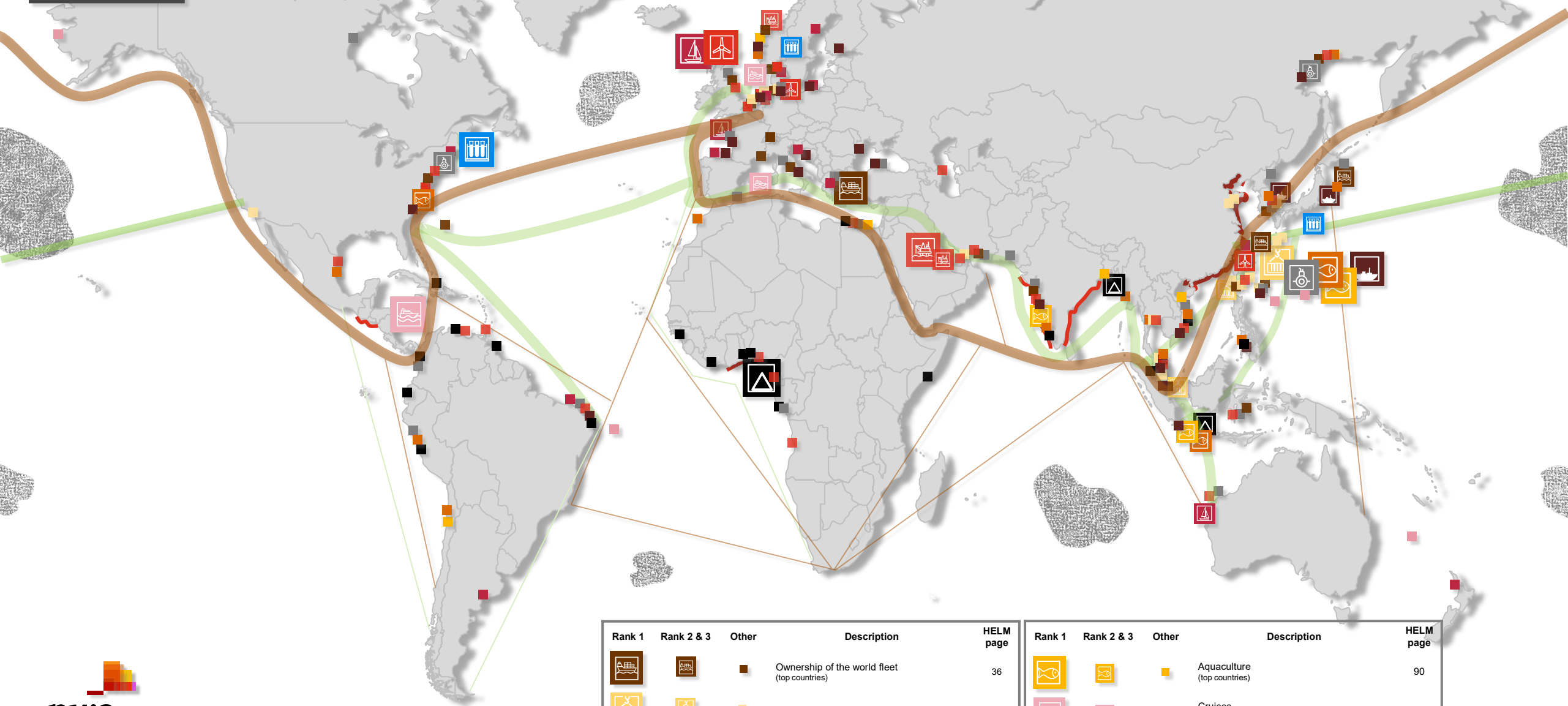


Economy of the Sea Map
